Instructions: In groups of 3-4 you will plan a vacation for a “family of four” ON A BUDGET! Your group will draw a budget for your vacation out of a hat. Your group can plan a camping trip, road trip, cruise, or plane trip but you must stay within your Budget. As a group you will create a travel brochure detailing the location of your trip and the exciting activities that it offers. Each Team member will be responsible for one aspect of the trip (Transportation, Housing, Food, Events & Attractions. Additionally, as a group, you will create a day-to-day itinerary of your “family’s” activities. You will have 1 day in the classroom to prepare and 3 additional workdays in the computer lab to research and create your brochure. You will present your vacation as a group on ____ / ____.

Project Requirements:

1. Vacation Plan (in class work day)
2. Travel Brochure
3. Day-to-day itinerary w/expense breakdown (on back panel of brochure)

Things you must budget:

- Transportation Expenses:
 - Gas (all trips, but mainly road trip)
 - account for an average of **30 mpg**, at a rate of **\$3.50/gallon**
 - use google maps to calculate distance
 - Flight?
 - Campsite fee?
 - Cruise tickets?
- Housing:
 - Hotel, RV(12 mpg), Tents, Cruise Ship, etc. (What does it look like? Does it have a view?)
- Food:
 - Groceries/snacks
 - Eating out
- Attractions/Events:
 - Shows, concerts, Museums, etc. (What are you going to do while on vacation?)
