Use the blank outline map of Vietnam and fill in the following locations. Make sure you follow the directions exactly! Use page # 545 in new book to complete.

Label the following countries:

1. North Vietnam (color orange)
2. South Vietnam (color green)
3. China (color purple)
4. Burma (color yellow)
5. Laos (color red)
6. Cambodia (color pink)

Label the following bodies of water (color water blue):

South China Sea, Gulf of Tonkin, Gulf of Thailand

Label the following cities:

- A. In North Vietnam: Dien Bien Phu, Hanoi, Haiphong, Vinh, Dong Hoi
- B. In South Vietnam: Hue, Da Nang, Chulai, Kon Tum, Cam Rahn Bay, Bien Hoa, Saigon

Label and draw in (black or brown colored pencil):

1. Demarcation Line, 1954 (the line that would divide North and South Vietnam)
2. Draw 2 battle ships in the Gulf of Tonkin (U.S. Seventh Fleet, 1964, where the Gulf of Tonkin Incident occurred)
3. Draw in Ho Chi Minh Trail (the supply route that helped the Vietcong guerrillas move weapons, materials, and man power from the North to the South)

Answer the following geography skill builder questions on the back of your map:

1. Look at the key on the map in the book. Did the Saigon government of South Vietnam or the Vietcong guerrillas control more of South Vietnam in 1973?
2. Look at the graph on the map in the book. Which country committed the most troops to the war in Vietnam?
